1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict of languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to all classes.
- 2.2 All entries are to be received via the online entry form
<http://rayc.webentry.com.au/regatta.php?regattaid=1> (www.rayc.org.nz/sail-akarana/)
- 2.3 Entries close midnight 13 February 2011, late entry will apply after this time.
- 2.4 By starting a boat acknowledges that an entry fee is payable. If no entry fee is paid before or on the day of racing no results will be published for that boat.
- 2.5 Skippers and Crews are required to be financial members of an affiliated yacht or sailing club.

3. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Single Handed Classes - \$35.00 (per boat)

Fully Crewed Classes - \$65.00 (per boat)

Late Entry Surcharge - \$20.00 (per boat)

No warning signal will be made after 1500 hours on Sunday 19 February.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 1300 on Friday 17 February at RAYC or via the website www.rayc.org.nz

6. VENUE

- 6.1 The host club is Royal Akarana Yacht Club.
- 6.2 Racing will be conducted in the area north of the Orakei wave screen or any other area deemed suitable by the start boat on the day of racing.

7. THE COURSES

All courses will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 When from seven (7) to eleven (11) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.5 When twelve (12) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 10.2 The Race Channel will be VHF 77 unless the Race Officer advises otherwise.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded dependent on the number of entries received.

12. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in the event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at the discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
